- Integrates with Campus Solutions



WHAT ARE WE DOING?

- Curriculum Live in September
- Catalog: built with 25-26 catalog and approved proposals for the 26-27 catalog, goes live with the 26-27 catalog (May 2026)



- Integrated with Campus Solutions
 - Course prerequisites and major, sequence, minor, certificate requirements must all still be built directly in CS by the Registrar's curriculum staff, these are not integrated with Coursedog
- New and revised course proposals must be fully approved BEFORE program proposals can be started
- Any major that has multiple degree options
 - Each one requires an individual proposal



- Anchor Syllabus required
- Undergraduate Sample Plans of Study (referred to as Degree Maps by Coursedog)
- Listing program requirements
 - This will need to be done for new and revised programs



- Proposal information produces the catalog copy (requirements)
- Major/Minor/Certificate = Plan
- Sequence = Suplan
- Graduate Programs
 - 1 catalog



- Coursedog uses the term Voting for approving proposals
- No co-authors
- No Strikethrough or highlighting to show changes
 - The proposal will show the changes made



CURRICULUM-RELATED FORMS

- Financial Implications Form
 - Must be fully approved before submitting the related curriculum proposal
- Request A New Course Subject Code
- Request To Add Hours To Existing Major/Minor/Certificate
 - Must be fully approved before submitting the related curriculum proposal
