Generally, only capitalize the first letter, unless a 3-letter subject is	being indicated. Here are some examples:
Required courses	Thesis option elective courses
Elective courses	If a subject must be specified, there are 2 alternatives:
Professional education courses	300-level history elective courses (OR) 300-level
300-level elective courses	HIS elective courses

When adding directions in requirements, try to use Complete_XYZ instead of <u>Take_XYZ</u>.
